



East Sheen Primary School Our Home School Agreement

It is by working together that we will be able to promote a positive atmosphere within which our children can flourish. We ask you to read this agreement and discuss it with your child so reflecting this partnership.

As a parent/carer I try to:

- Make sure my child attends school every day.
- Make sure my child arrives on time, properly equipped for school and wearing correct school uniform.
- Inform the school on the first day of any absence.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour.
- Support my child in any work sent home and other home learning opportunities.
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions about my child's progress.
- Get to know about my child's life at school.
- Respect the privacy of all children in school, seeking permission before posting any photographic/video material online.
- Communicate with the school staff in a courteous and respectful manner, recognising school staff have the right to work without fear of abuse or threatening behaviour in line with our policies (available on our website).
- Communicate with school through the published appropriate channels via email or phonecall to the school office and not through social media (including WhatsApp).
- Respect others in the school community and embrace the inclusive nature of our school.

The staff at East Sheen Primary will ensure that:

- We care for your child's safety and happiness.
- We encourage children to believe in themselves, feel valued, and achieve their full potential.
- We provide a balanced, stimulating, and well-taught curriculum to meet the individual needs of your child.
- We achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility.
- We keep you informed about general school matters and your child's progress in particular.
- We are open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the life of the school.
- We contact parents at an early stage should any problems arise.

Together we will try to:

- Share any concerns or problems that might affect the child's work or behaviour.
- Support the child's educational and social development.
- Prepare the child to be a confident and happy member of society.

As a pupil of East Sheen Primary School I will:

- Come to school every day, and be on time with all my equipment.
- Do my best both in class and in my homework.
- Be well-behaved and sensible.
- Be polite and helpful to others and respect all other members of our school community and their property.
- Follow our school rules.

We listen in class.

We follow instructions from all adults working in the school.

We always walk around our school quietly.

We keep hands, feet and objects to ourselves.

We always speak kindly without teasing, name calling or swearing.

- Ensure that toys and games brought into school are 'pocket-sized' and that anything that could cause harm to myself or other people is left at home.
- Share and talk about any problems I have and ask for help when I need it.
- Wear school uniform, take pride in my appearance, and remember that I represent my school at all times.
- Take care of school equipment, our building and the school surroundings.
- Pass on information to my parents.

If I have a problem...

- I'll try talking to the other person to see if we can sort things out.
- I'll tell a grown up as soon as I can.
- The grown up will follow up the problem as soon as possible.
