Amongst many activities, they used 'bomb disposal devices' to test their steady hand skills and the highlight for many children was the stretcher race; 2 teams raced against each other to help evacuate the 'wounded soldiers'. In the feedback survey, 97% of parents found the booking process easy and 99% of parents felt well or somewhat informed about their child's current attainment. 70% of parents preferred face-to-face meetings and 27% preferred having a choice on online or face-to-face meetings. Some comments raised the limitations of the school's internet connection for holding online meetings, which we will look at with our IT provider. While some comments felt that meetings were short, the fifteen-minute windows offered are comparable or greater than other local schools and already require 450 minutes of teacher meeting time.
