Classes 5S, 5B and 5M

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to another fun, rewarding and busy year at ESPS!

This is the first of our termly bulletins where we aim to provide you with information concerning areas of the curriculum and important dates for the term ahead. A timetable is also attached for your reference.

You are invited to the Year 5 Curriculum Evening on Tuesday 19th September, at 6pm in the school hall.

Homework

- <u>Reading</u>(daily): We expect children to spend 30 minutes a night reading independently and, where possible, with an adult. The children must bring their Reading Record to school each day and take it home each evening to record their reading. On a weekly basis, the children will have the opportunity to quiz on the books they have read, testing their vocabulary and comprehension knowledge through the Renaissance Reading Scheme.
- <u>MyMaths</u> (set Thursday completed by the following Wednesday): This will be based on the lessons covered during the week. Children are expected to continue to learn their times tables using times table rockstars.
- <u>Spellings</u>: Spelling rules will be taught weekly with suggested words that follow these rules being looked at during these sessions. We will test the rules the following Thursday, using some of the suggested words, alongside others, to ensure the children have mastered the rule. These rules, with the suggested words, are found on the Year 5 webpage and a task is set weekly on **spellingshed.com**.

PE Kit

We would ask for your assistance in ensuring that your child arrives to school in his/her **correct** PE kit on **Mondays and Fridays**. The correct PE kit is made up of the school blue PE t-shirt, a pair of black shorts for indoor wear and a pair of black tracksuit bottoms for outdoor wear and sturdy trainers. Please note that football tops are NOT permitted.

English

Our lessons cover all aspects of reading, writing, grammar and punctuation and spoken language. The children will study a wide selection of fiction and non-fiction texts throughout the year and develop their learning through many drama opportunities. A range of interesting texts will be explored this year including 'The Highwayman' and 'Beowulf'.

Maths

All maths work will be taught in accordance with the National Curriculum. This term we will cover: number and place value, addition and subtraction, statistics, multiplication and division and perimeter and area. These will be taught through the use of mathematical manipulatives and visual aids. We assess times-tables **each Thursday** (the children will be made aware of which tables to focus on each week), arithmetic and mental maths are covered on a bi-weekly basis.

Science - Properties and Changes of Materials

The children will study 'Properties and Changes of Materials' and explore concepts such as reversible and irreversible changes. We plan, carry out and evaluate a range of investigations and experimental activities.

Computing

Through the year, we constantly refresh our knowledge and skills in e-safety. We will learn about potential online dangers.

Unit 1 Search Engines: Before half-term, children will learn how search engines work. We will learn to use key words and phrases; and how to identify inaccurate information.

Unit 2 Programming of Music: After half-term, children will use their coding skills to create sounds and melodies

History – Anglo-Saxons and Vikings

The children will learn about different aspects of Anglo-Saxon Britain and The Vikings. This includes their lives, origins, travel and exploration, mythology and warfare.

PSHE & RE

In PSHE lessons, we will continue to use Jigsaw, the mindful approach to PSHE (Personal, Social, Health Education) which is a teaching and learning programme that includes the statutory RSHE (Relationships, Sex and Health Education) curriculum and has a strong focus on emotional and mental health and wellbeing. This term, the children will cover 'Being Me in My World' and in RE we will be studying Sikhism.

Thinking Schools

The children will continue to use tools from their 'Thinking School' toolkit, including thinking maps, thinking hats and habits of mind. The 'Thinking School' methodologies aim to equip children with the thinking skills needed to effectively tackle problems across and beyond the curriculum, both at school and in the future, through deep and critical thinking.

Music

This year, children will be taught music by specialist teacher, Miss Imogen Ridge. As well as weekly singing assemblies and regular singing in class, children will listen to, perform and explore a wide range of music. In Year 5 this term, the children will be exploring pulse, rhythm and rounds.

Art and D&T - Pop Art and Viking Longboat Making

In Art we will use different media and techniques, as well as looking at the origins of Pop Art and some of its more famous artists. In D&T, the children will research and make their own Viking Longboats. This will be incorporated in our Viking Day.

Physical Education (PE)

Friday sessions are led by sports coaches from the company NSSport. Children will take part in tag rugby, hockey and basketball. In indoor PE, the children will be taking part in invasion games (netball) and gymnastics.
