



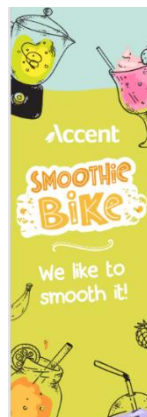
East Sheen Primary School Newsletter Friday 1st March

Sports Challenge:



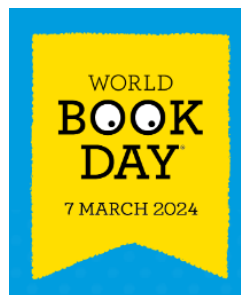
Every week, our Sports Captains set the school a challenge. This week it is to complete 15 Jumping Jacks before watching something on television.
