#### Air Pollution and Health:

Please see the following message from the borough's Public Health Team:

Dear East Sheen parents/carers, I'm a GP trainee currently working with the Public Health Team based at Richmond Council. I am doing a project looking at air pollution and its impact on health. The aim is to find out how we can best reach out to our populations to help raise awareness of the health impacts of Air Pollution, and to discuss what you can do to protect yourselves and your family.

As part of this work, I would like to speak to some parents in the borough about air pollution and health. The information gained will help inform the next steps on communications and engagement about Air Quality, Climate Change and Health.

This would involve an interview of up to 1 hour, either virtually or in person, and will be audio recorded. I will follow all the General Data Protection Regulations and will take your consent before proceeding with the interview. All the information recorded from the interview would be transcribed, and all the interview recordings will be deleted afterwards. All your responses will be treated with strict confidence
