

At ESPS, we want to make sure all children are safe, happy and ready to learn. The adults are trained to help keep everyone safe - this means we work hard to stop anything bad from happening to children and know what to do if we think someone is being hurt or help them if they are worried about anything.

Here's what the adults do to keep everyone safe:

- We have clear steps everyone in the school follows if there's a worry about safety.
- We are trained to notice if something might be wrong, so we know what to do and who to tell.
- We keep an eye on children who might be in danger.
- We talk to everyone involved when there's a worry about a child, including parents, carers, and outside helpers like the police and children's services. We share important information quickly to make sure children get the help they need.
