Thursday 9th October; Thursday 13th November; and Thursday 11th December. If you would like to book an appointment, please complete the [form attached](#).

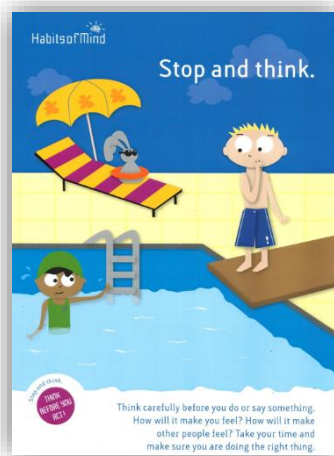


DBS checks:
