ESPS was inspected by Ofsted in April 2023 and achieved the ‘outstanding’ grade in all areas. ESPS governors held a strategy day at the end of June 2023 to determine the school’s medium-term goals following this recognition of outstanding practice. Our four-year goals (2023-2027) were established after consultation with the headship team, senior leaders, the governing body, input from staff (through INSET days and the annual staff survey), pupils and parents.

Our goals support the school’s vision: ‘Our purpose is to nurture happy, confident children who think deeply about themselves and others in preparation for the challenges ahead.

We do this by inspiring and celebrating: curiosity and love for learning; collaboration and kindness; creativity and enthusiasm; resilience and achievement.’
