Star reading assessment every half term.

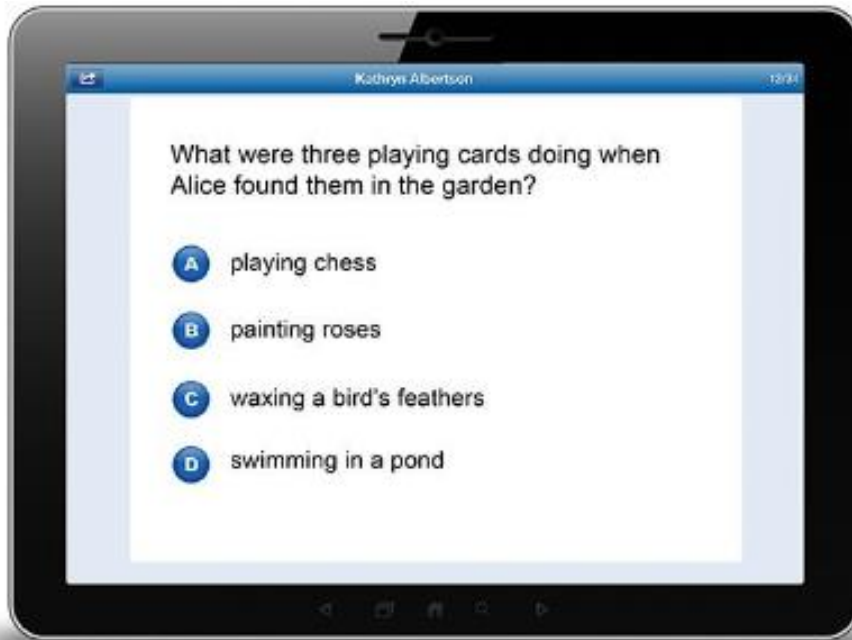
A range of book levels recommended for each student based on their reading ability

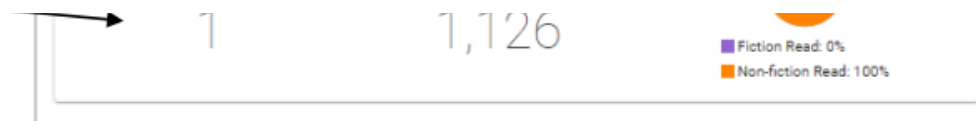

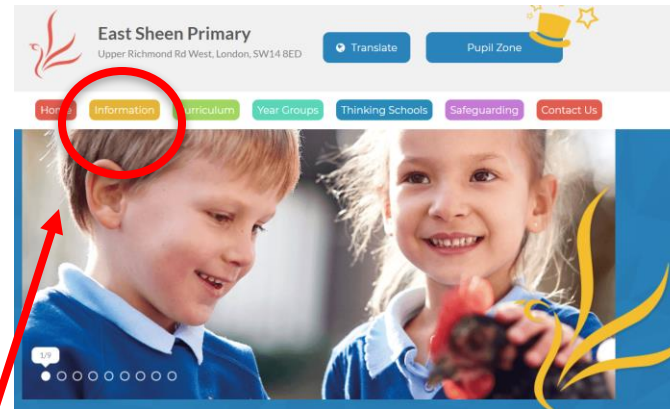

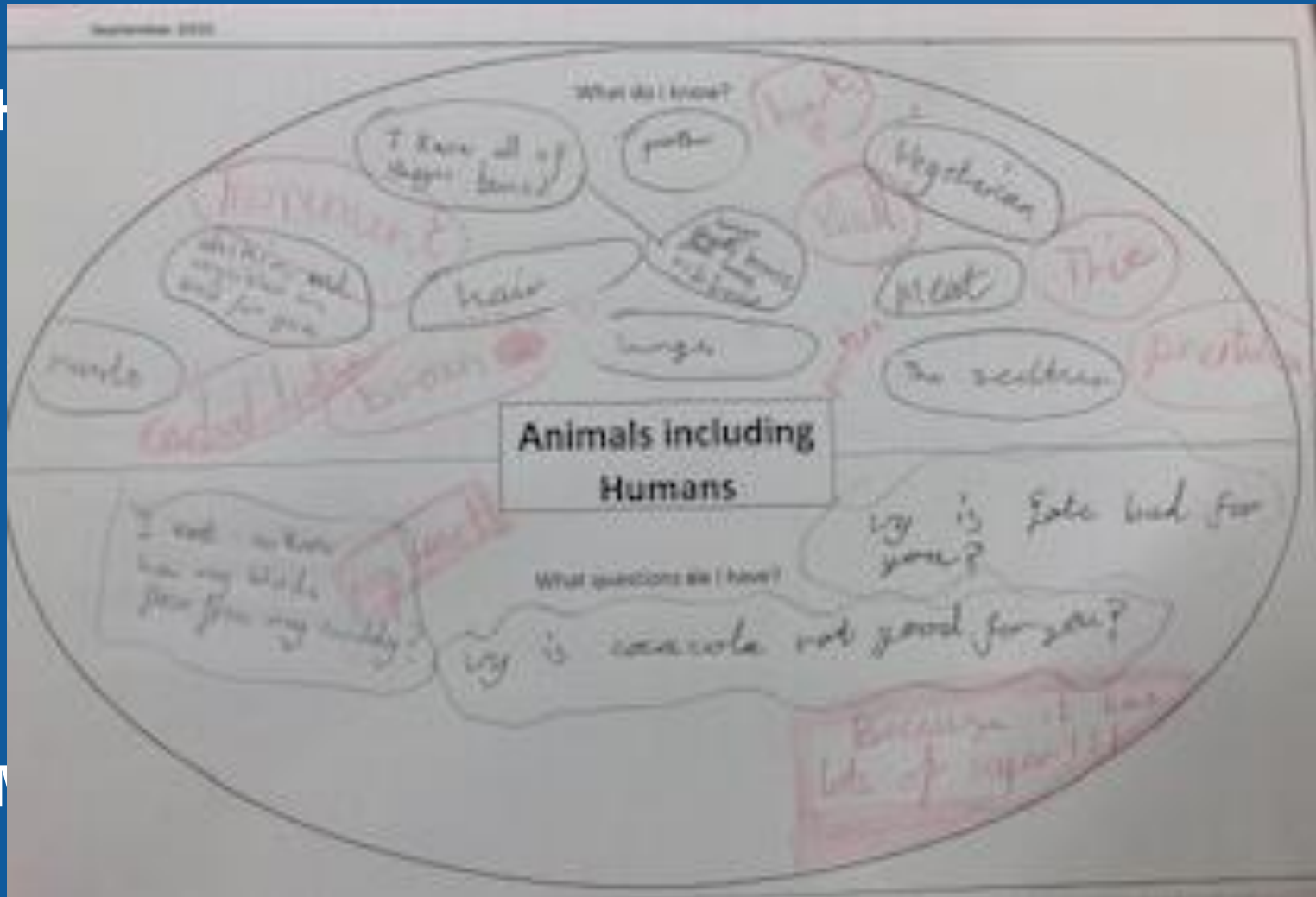
Home learning
