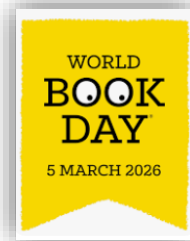


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World Book Day 2026

Well done to our Sports Star this week, R in 3S. This was for showing great persistence during his swimming lessons.



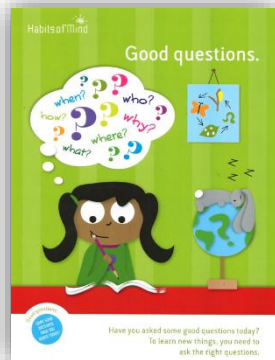
