



**Welcome to East Sheen Primary School Parent Teacher Association (ESPS PTA)** and thanks for coming to our PTA coffee morning today. We have recently taken over as Co-Chairs of the PTA and are looking for keen, enthusiastic parents to join us.

Our PTA was formed in 1972 just after the school was badly damaged by fire. We are a registered charity ( no. 273295) and members of the National Council of Parent Teachers Association.

The PTA has two core roles:

- 1 - To raise funds using a range of fundraising events to purchase items that the school would otherwise be unable to provide.
- 2- To help develop and sustain positive relationships between all parents and between parents and teachers. We do this with social events and a whole variety of consultation opportunities.

Our PTA can be proud of their achievements. Research shows that on average a school PTA will raise £10k per annum versus ESPPA £40k per annum.

Over the last few years our main achievements have been to fund:

- £4k to Astro Turf the grass between Reception and Year 1 (2017)
- £8k for 30 new iPads (2016)
- £5k for Reception climbing frame (2016)
- £17k towards re-stocking the junior library (2015)
- £40k for the music lodge (2014)

Alongside smaller projects such as providing numeracy support, replenishing art supplies, buying playground and sports equipment to mention but a few.
