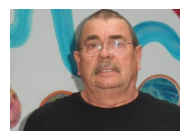
World Book Day

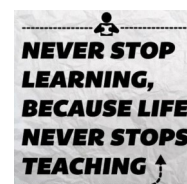
Mr Hambridge has celebrated his 70th birthday this week. 70 must be the new 50! We all wish him many happy returns...
