

Children, Families and Community Committee

The Children, Families and Communities Committee comprises, parent, staff, co-opted and associate governors. It enthusiastically engages with pupils, staff, parents and the broader community in support of the children's learning and developmental journeys, endeavouring to inspire a strong school spirit.

Taking into account the School's Vision and Ethos the committee more specifically:

- Recommends ways to promote pupil wellbeing
- Scrutinises safeguarding practice within the school
- Acts to engage parents in school life
- Supports staff in delivery of their targets
- Assesses and promotes ESPS's reputation as a school that provides an excellent broad based education for its local community
- Considers external and internal changes to the school environment and evaluates the impact on the school community
- Communicates findings to the Full Governing Board and the wider community

Committee activities include:

- Conducting and evaluating an annual Parent Satisfaction Survey
- Conducting and evaluating an annual Y6 Exit and Leavers questionnaire
- Carrying out policy reviews
- Agreeing content of the biannual Governors' Newsletter
- Monitoring School website content and usage

There are typically two committee meetings each term during which annual committee targets are set and reviewed, safeguarding matters and attendance are examined and relevant policies re-evaluated (on a rotating schedule and taking into account changes in legislation). It is a collaborative committee that really gets to the roots of school life.
