## Rainforest Assembly



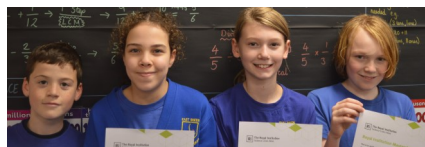
