Royal Academy Young Artists Summer Competition

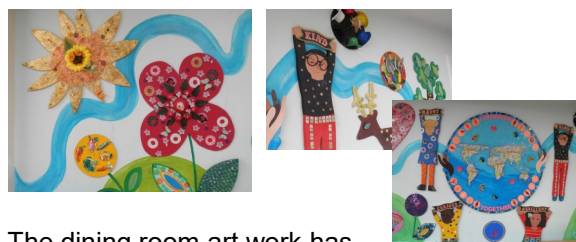


Huge congratulations to F (5T) whose artwork was selected for the Royal Academy Summer Exhibition. What a fabulous achievement. The link to the online exhibition is
