Bees have a very important part to play in maintaining our planet. Where trees and woods are essential to filter our air, bees are vital to both pollinate the food we need to survive and pollinate many of the trees and flowers that provide habitats for wildlife.

... a third of the world's food production depends on **bees**!

Unfortunately, bees and other pollinating insects are in sharp decline because of the loss of their habitats and the use of harmful chemicals and pesticides in farming.

We can all help to preserve bees and other pollinators.

Here are some ideas:

Plant nectar-bearing flowers on balconies, terraces and in gardens.

- Buy honey and other hive products from your nearest local beekeeper or buy local honey from grocery shops in your area.
- Build a 'bug hotel' to encourage pollinating insects to visit your garden or balcony.
